2 WAIT

Wait three days for a response to your request. Affected utilities will send a locator to mark any underground utility lines. Keep in mind utilities are not required to mark any private lines.

3 CONFIRM

Confirm that all affected utilities have responded by comparing the markers to the list of utilities the 8-1-1 call center notified

A RESPECT

Respect the markers provided by the affected utilities. They are your guide for the duration of your project.

5 DIG CAREFULLY

If you can't avoid digging near the markers (within 18-24 inches on all sides) consider moving your projects.
